

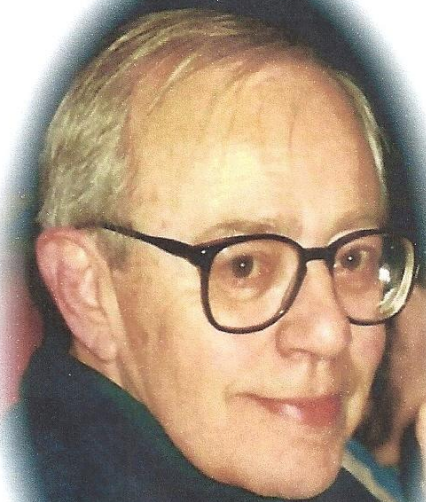
## In Memoriam

**His Family.....**David Hamilton, age 66, passed away peacefully on the evening of July 1, 2007 with his loving family at his side. He was survived by his devoted wife of 37 years, Ada L. Hamilton, and two children, son James of Ann Arbor, Michigan, and daughter Erin Hamilton and husband Brian Stibitz, along with grandson Oscar Stibitz, all of Anchorage, Alaska. He is also survived by brother Richard Hamilton of Dallas, Texas, brother Robert Hamilton and wife Diana of Cleveland, Ohio, sister Sally Fairbanks and husband Douglas of Naples, Florida, along with 8 nieces and nephews and 6 grandnieces and grandnephews.

**His Legacy.....**David was born September 9, 1940 in Newton, Massachusetts to Ralph and Doris I. Hamilton. David spent his childhood years in Toledo, Ohio. He served in the United States Air Force from 1961 to 1965, then attended and graduated from University of Toledo with a BS in Geology. While at the university, David met and married Ada L. Poole. Together they moved to Hamburg Township in 1976, where they have lived happily for more than 30 years. David was a devoted family man and a committed public servant, dedicating much of his time to the community. He served on Hamburg's volunteer fire department, immersed himself in church activities and became very active in local politics. He was proud to serve on the Livingston County Board of Commissioners for 16 years, and took to heart the task of representing taxpayers' interests as a founder of the Livingston County Taxpayers' Association. His activism and tireless concern for others will be lovingly remembered by all who knew him.
