Edward Slack: Graduated from Whitmer High School in 1959. I was born in June, 1939.

I would have graduated in 1958, but repeated the Junior year and fondly remember the Class of 1958, having shared many of the same classes and events for six years. That's why I still consider the Class of 1958 as my own. After graduation, I enlisted in the Air Force, attended Bowling Green State University and left for California in 1966, living for over 30 years in the San Francisco Bay Area. I also lived in Fresno, Oakland, Oxnard; San Diego; and Visalia, CA; and later North

Dakota. I worked in Sequoia and Yosemite National Parks in the 1970s, and attended two junior colleges in California.

While living in San Francisco, I specialized in medical transcription over twelve years. I learned conversational Russian, joined a Russian Men's Choir in San Francisco; and sang in the world premiere recording with them.

I returned to Toledo in 1993 when my mother's second husband passed away, retired in the late 1990s; and earned supplemented benefits driving ambulance, limousine; and delivering as an independent contractor. I studied night courses at University College on the UT campus.

In 2005, I co-founded the Toledo History Museum (www.toledohistorymuseum.org) being appointed president for 2006 and elected president for 2007. I now serve for 2008 as a Trustee and Public Relations Committee Chair.

I attend Westgate Chapel, a Christian & Missionary Alliance church. I earnestly support Ohio State especially against that Ann Arbor bunch.
